

**Prosecutor:** Did you talk to his brother?

**Accused:** No.

**Chairman:** The period of detention?

**Accused:** From 13:00 on May 22, 2014, until 17:00 the next day.

**Chairman:** When was he released and what was his condition?

**"Nos":** On the evening of May 23, 2014, around 17:00. He had a bag on his head and handcuffs, he was hanging from a ceiling beam. Did they demand money at gunpoint? Did they want to kill him in the morning? Did they break into the warehouse? Did they take the money? Did they threaten him with a knife? Did they demand three more cars? Did they give him time to think it over until the next morning? Did they offer a *krysha* (provided by "Piter"?)

**Chairman:** Who detained him?

**Prosecutor:** "Piter," on "Bolgar's" orders.

**Accused:** I didn't even try that, nor wanted it.

**Prosecutor:** It's all been proven.

**Defender:** No more questions.

**Chairman:** Why did you detain him? On what grounds?

**Accused:** There was no intent. We didn't want anything from him. We'd been deceived.

**"Nos":** No other episodes have been proven.

Hearing the charge of Nikolai Aleksandrovich Lukyanov ("Luka"), commander of 2nd platoon of the unit of "Balu."

**Prosecutor:** On May 22, 2014, "Luka" received information about the metal warehouse and a car. They organized a group without reporting it and left the checkpoint and the unit vulnerable. He saw the car by the warehouse. He found out the address of the owner from the gatekeeper (address, material values). He went to that address, broke into the house while the owner was absent and reported it to "Bolgar." He collected personal belongings and took them to his checkpoint. He discredited the National Liberation Movement of the DNR, marauded, didn't follow orders. Next morning, he went to the warehouse without reporting it to his commander (and seized a rifle). In the afternoon, he came to the cellar and demanded the car keys. He refused to discuss it. He interfered with the investigation.
